We employ both work study and departmental[^] funded student employees as childcare assistants in the classrooms, offering learning and experiences that support their career choices. We collaborate with the Woodring Early Childhood Education Department to provide internship, practicum, as well as observation for class, including ECE Environment Class, and ECE Creativity and Play. We also enable other academic departments to place students for projects related to young children, such as Environmental Studies, Art Department, Leadership Studies, Engineering and Design.
