Levi Eckman, Interim Senate Pro-Tempore, called the meeting to order at 6:07 PM.

III. PUBLIC FORUM *(comments from students and the community)*

- A. Abdul Malik Ford spoke to the Senate about the elections grievances that he submitted to the AS Elections Grievance Board against AS Student Senator

Dayjha McMillan and AS Board Executives. Asked for the system to be analyzed and changed due to the amount of unchecked powers.

IV. INFORMATION ITEMS – Guests*

A. AS Election Code Violation

Eckman introduced Bennett Massey-Helber, Chair of the AS Elections Grievance Board. Massey-Helber shared the referral of grievances letter and clarified that they have not ruled that anyone on the Executive Board except for Anne Lee is in violation of the code. Eckman stated that he would not be voting on this item and does not believe that he broke the Election Code. Yoshiyama asked what constitutes an endorsement according to the Code. A recess is called. Nora Harren said there is not a specific definition in the Elections Code. Yoshiyama said that since three out of the five candidates were found in violation, there must be some standard for finding violation. Massey-Helber said that their interpretation was if someone makes a clear endorsement and someone shares it with clear benefit, it is a violation. Hensyel asked why they did not find any of the Executive Board in violation. Harren said that this will be for the Student Senate to decide because they do not have jurisdiction over the Executive Board. Embly asked McMillan to talk about their decision to publish a post against Ford. McMillan responded that they had a conversation with Ford following a candidate forum about their discontent with previous conversations between the two and McMillan's belief that Ford was taking credit for work he did not do. Yoshiyama asked Executive Board members Solomon, Eckman, and Lee to speak to their reasoning for their actions. Solomon responded that she was representing her community and McMillan's message was incredibly important, and McMillan was sharing her experience which is valid as a student, and being a candidate should not be used to silence her experiences. Lee stated that they shared McMillan's post because McMillan took a vulnerable position to share their experiences with Ford, and that Lee decided to stand in solidarity with QTPOC and McMillan's desire to step up to raise visibility on the issues. Solomon added that there was another grievance filed against her that she does not see as breaking any rules, as she was expressing her opinion about a supposed anti-black conversation happening on twitter, and shared the source in order to prove that the conversation was not what was thought. They then added that the candidate conduct agreement does not apply to them as they are not candidates and that Malik was directly in violation of it posting things that are slanderous towards the WWU election process after the results were posted. [Motion] Eckman asked Ford to share his opinion on the topic. Ford responded that he believed he did not yell at McMillan in the interaction, nor did he tower over her. Ford then told the senate that he was not yelling during a conversation and asked Solomon to clarify what damaging and harmful things he had done and that Solomon's reposting on twitter endangered the individual. Ford did not know McMillan was a senator when he filed the grievance and that 124 votes is a close race when you consider the scope of the Executive Board's influence. Massey-Helber clarified that the Grievance Board did not find that McMillan broke the Code, as the Code does not cover dis-endorsements. McMillan stated

that there was yelling during the conversation with Ford and then added that they released their statement after considering statements that were not released concerning these issues and conversations with Hessami about whether sharing experiences was breaking code, and was told that this was not. As well as pointed out that Ford left several individual's identity in the public record with his post, therefore accusing someone else of it is hypocritical at best. [Motion] Eckman said he will be deleting these documents from the website to protect identities after this process is complete. Solomon stated that she shouldn't have shared the screenshot of a student and took it down upon request and that Ford may not consider it yelling, but he was told at the time that he had to lower his voice and calm down, which many consider yelling. Romo stated the Elections Committee has already held hearings about what has happened and that this does not need to be a discussion about "if" something has happened, but whether or not they should be found in violation. Yokuda stated that there was not much in explicit endorsement. Eckman reminded the Senate of it jurisdiction in this discussion is Levi Eckman, Millka Solomon, and Camilla Mejía and Anne Lee. Anne Koltiska stated that he believes it is valuable for McMillan to have spoken out however they did support another candidate which violates the elections code. Makrakis asked a sanction would be overseen by the Executive Board. Eckman said yes because they are overseeing someone from the Senate, the same way the Senate is overseeing the board and that it is not a conflict of interest because though it is the same type of grievance the jurisdiction is different. Soulliere stated that sharing a post concerning a personal experience is not an endorsement and any decision made today would be disappointing as it is censorship of personal experiences. Noesen stated that she believed that Lee broke the code because Lee endorsed candidates. Tran asked if it was in the Senate's jurisdiction to change the Election Code. Eckman responded that the Executive Board currently is the only body that writes the Election Code. Romo said that it is a committee that works in both drafting and elections committee. [Motion.] Akelipa stated that none of the Executive Board should be held in violation because the code should not be used to silence student voices. Lee stated that they do feel they were in violation of code, though they felt their speaking out was necessary. Makrakis asked for precedent on sanctions. Eckman said they could require a statement. [Motion] McMillan added that it is important to recognize the weight of restorative justice and asked Ford what he would like to see. Ford stated that he does not feel comfortable commenting on it, due to being unsure of what can happen. Eckman said they could do this via email vote. Solomon stated that requiring a statement in coordination with others would not have the effect desired, as Lee had already put thought into her actions. Makrakis proposed Lee doing community service to a club. McMillan said that recognizing the weight of restorative justice that Lee had already paid in restorative justice with the repercussions of her actions. Lee responded that they have had conversations with their advisor about the Elections Board's decision and is assisting in finding ways to ensure this doesn't happen again.
