# A. ACC Funding Request

Jenet Habtemariam said their outside vendor was approved by University Dining and that their catering budget had dropped considerably, to around \$4,000. Mwangi asked if they would be changing the amount they were requesting. Habtemariam said they would not because they haven't heard from RHA. She said they would be talking with them Thursday, February 9<sup>th</sup>. She added that they have received \$1,000 from Willy Hart and \$2,000 from the Diversity Fund. ACC is still asking for \$3,500. Duot asked what their total budget is.

#### ASWWU Board of Directors

Habtemariam said it is \$6,500. Habtemariam added that their VU Services costs are now \$1,100 because they are holding their after party in the MPR as well. Jaradi stated that if ACC received a minimum of \$100 from RHA, Steering could give them less money. Jaradi suggested creating a stipulation in the motion that would allow for Steering to give ACC less money if they did receive funding from RHA. There was consensus amongst the committee members.
