## Event Overview

Description for event and/or biography of speaker, performer etc.

QPOC is hoping to attend the 3rd Queer Students of Color conference organized by and hosted at Portland State University. This will be a 3-day conference for queer people of color and their allies; it will be focused around the theme "Radical Self-Care and the Decolonized Mind". The purpose of this conference is to foster and support a growing number of activists and scholars in the region; it will also help us to make connections with other QPOC groups in the Pacific Northwest. The conference will consist of a variety of workshops, including "Masculinities and the TransUnheard Project", a keynote speech by Mia Mingus, a concert, and a dance party. We will be staying for two nights at the University Place Hotel, which has discounted rates though PSU, and using 1 AS vehicle and personal vehicles to get there.

The target audience for the program and expected outcomes

The target audience for this event is interested QPOC club members. The expected outcomes for this conference are: Learn practices for healthy self care, learn tools for a "Decolonized Mind", network and build community with other Queer People of Color & Allies and with other QPOC clubs/organizations, learn about issues facing Queer Students of Color and how to address them, learn about organizations working for Social Justice and centered around QPOC, provide a space for club members to explore and affirm their identities.

Past attendance records, if available, and/or success of similar events on other campuses

9 members of WWU'S QPOC successfully attended the 1st QsOC conference in April 2011. It was a valuable learning experience, as well as an opportunity for our club to get to know each other better. There was a showing of the film Still Black: A Portrait of Black Transmen the first night, followed by two days of conferences on topics such as representation of black lesbians in film, eating disorders in QPOC communities, privilege & oppression, as well as a keynote speaker.

The benefit that will be given to the student body, and how it fits within the mission statement and goals of the Ethnic Student Center and Associated Students

Members who attend this conference will learn and grow from it and bring that growth back to campus where they will have the ability to become *student* activists. They may *also* learn skills for *coping on a* predominantly white and heterosexual campus. This fits within the AS mission statement as it will "help students define themselves" and find allies. It also fits within the ABC's of the esc by affirming student's identities, building community within our club and with other QPOCs, and by cultivating student activism. This conference will also encourage students to seek knowledge beyond/outside of the classroom and academic settings.
