He heard that there are a lot of issues within the community and how they see the ESC. He doesn't want anyone to feel unsafe or threatened, and wants to make sure everyone is okay. Duot said he is an ESC member, and if anything happens, he will join and be a part of the group. With this issue, he said it's difficult for everyone. He said thanks to everyone who protested. He said he can take it as a challenge, and asked if he is being clear. He said it's not a big thing to be talked about. He said he can forget what is going on and stand in solidarity with them. Espinoza-Gonzalez said nobody has to talk about it, he just wants to make sure everyone's okay. Penor said that she feels like there is a back lash now because of it. She saw on a post on Viking Village about it, and people were asking why ESC members weren't chiming in. She said she feels like there are people who are constantly voicing their opinions. Espinoza-Gonzalez said it's a hard issue. He wants everyone to let their clubs know that the ESC is here for them. Panelo agreed with Espinoza-Gonzalez about being concerned with students and their well-being. He wants to make sure students feel supported by the ESC, and mentioned that the ESC is a support staff. Everybody is at a different spectrum, and he said they are there to support that, too. He doesn't agree with the Western Front, but there were a few things that they did cover well. He finished by saying that they should be there to support each other. Duot apologized for raising his voice if it did.
