V. INFORMATION ITEMS - Steering Representatives

A. KhSA Heritage Dinner Funding Request

Neil Dezarn said April 20th is their third annual Heritage Dinner, which will be held at Sehome High School. They don't have the budget document but they are asking for \$2,500. As far as co-sponsors, they are getting \$1,000 from RHA. Dezarn said the current estimate for

catering is \$4,000. They are hoping to get the number lowered because they are having a member who can make most of the food. They will be also be going through Aramark. They will have a Cambodian kick boxing performance, which will be \$50. Tickets will be \$8 for students, and \$12 for the general public. They are hoping to sell out this year. Espinoza-Gonzalez asked how many tickets were sold last year. Dezarn said they sold out 300 tickets. Kirchmeier asked if the event will be formal. Dezam said it will be semi-formal. Deng explained that there was a mix up with the documents, and that is why they don't have their budget document. He said when Panelo is back next week, they will all have the figures and this will return as an Action Item.

B. TSU Heritage Dinner Funding Request

Jamie Bradford, the budget authority, said they are asking for \$1,500 from Steering Council. The costs will be a little more than what they've fundraised, but they are still proactively fundraising. Their theme is "Celebrate Your Culture and Fife Will Celebrate You". Cecily, a WWU professor, will be their keynote speaker. They are currently also holding tryouts for performances. The cost for tickets is \$16 for the general public, and \$10 for students. Kirchmeier asked what "dining" means on their budget document. Ochoa said they are hoping to do a dining fundraiser, and also one with Menchies. They are in the process of going through RHA and Diversity Funding. Espinoza-Gonzalez asked if any funds have been approved yet. Ochoa said it's all still in the works.

C. MEChA Nationals at UCSD Funding Request

Alanna Francis said right now MEChA is working on getting 5 students to the University of California in San Diego for Nationals, which will be a four day long event. She said MEChA isn't just a club at this school, but it is also a national organization in community colleges and universities. They all get together once a year to make change and build on their community within themselves, and it is split up into different regions. She said their club really works on getting students down to represent Western Washington University. They are driving down because airplane tickets are too expensive. The way that they can get nationals to happen is by using funding from Steering. She said it's important to have Western represented at nationals. What they're asking for is funding for housing for four nights, and the cheapest is 15 minutes away from campus. The main costs for this will mostly be for gas and the overnight stay. They're planning on staying at family member's houses on the way down, and food is every individual's responsibility. Kirchmeier asked exactly how much is being asked for. Francis said they are asking for \$600. They're going to fit everyone in one room. Kirchmeier asked if they plan on making the trip in a day. Francis said on the way to, they will be making it on a trip down. Shayla Humphrey asked if they are using their own car. Francis said that she was going to use her personal car. She said that she was going to meet with Duot before the meeting about using an AS vehicle. Duot said if there is a question about anything, to ask now .He said that they can suspend the rules of operation since it is so soon on the 20th, and the process will take time. Dawson asked if we have a transportation funds. Duot said yes, we have \$2,000 set aside for transportation. He said this would be the way to utilize the money. Dawson asked if they can add another \$100 so they can sleep comfortably. The council agreed.
