| I.  | CHARGE     | <ul> <li>Legislative Affairs Council serves to increase student representation by:</li> <li>Encouraging civic engagement and student participation in the political process.</li> <li>Creating, reviewing, and proposing Local, State, Federal, and other proposed Legislative Agendas to the Associated Students of Western Washington University (ASWWU) Board of Directors.</li> <li>Submitting recommendations to the Washington Student Association (WSA) regarding the statewide Legislative Agenda.</li> <li>Establishing contact with elected officials to ensure that student perspectives are being considered at all levels of government.</li> <li>Formulating policy positions for all matters concerning students in higher education.</li> <li>Reviewing funding request proposals, making financial decisions, and</li> </ul> |

| Ш.  | CHAIR      | The Chairperson shall be the AS Vice President for Governmental Affairs. They shall convene the meetings, approve agendas, and preside at all meetings. The Vice-Chairperson shall be selected at the discretion of the council and acts in the absence of the Chairperson.   |
| IV. | MEETINGS   | Meetings shall be called by the Chair. The council shall meet at least twice prior to the establishment of an AS Legislative agenda. All meetings must be called with a minimum of twenty-four (24) hours notice. Meetings may also be called by any member with support of at least twenty-five percent (25%) of the seated, voting membership.  |
| V.  | VOTING     | In order for a motion to pass, it must obtain a majority of the legal votes cast. An abstention shall not count as a legal vote cast.   |
| VI. | QUORUM     | A majority of the voting membership shall constitute a quorum. If a quorum is<br>not present, the Chair will adjourn the meeting and reschedule to a new day and<br>hour. During the summer, and when not in academic session, this council's<br>responsibilities fall to the AS VP for Governmental Affairs with approval from<br>the AS President and Director of Student Activities.   |

| VII. RULES<br>OF OPERATION | The council may adopt and amend rules of operation governing its operation by a majority vote of the council, subject to review or approval by the AS Board. |
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| VIII. AMENDMENTS           | This Charter may be amended by a majority vote of the AS Board of Directors  |
| IX. REPORTAGE              | This council shall report to the AS Board of Directors through the AS Vice President for Governmental Affairs.   |
