Reason for Funding:

The Environmental and Sustainability Programs is hoping to host Western Washington University's second Environmental Lobby Day, scheduled for President's Day February 16th 2015. Environmental Lobby Day will provide an opportunity for any and all students to become actively involved in environmental policy and environmental issues. The ESP will craft a guiding legislative agenda where students will have the choice to take a stance on the issue at hand.
