International Divestment, Boycott, and Sanctions Taskforce Charge & Charter
March 2015

- I. CHARGE** This taskforce is charged with the critical exploration of the Implications of maintaining or repealing the resolution concerning the International Divestment, Boycott, and Sanctions (ASB-14-S-65) by:
- seeking new possibilities that better address the matter at hand.
 - advising the AS Board of Directors in the form of a final recommendation by the end of Spring Quarter 2015.
- II. MEMBERSHIP** AS VP for Activities (chair, non-voting)
AS President or designee (non-voting)
7 students at large, (voting) appointed by the AS Board of Directors
- III. CHAIR** The Chairperson shall be the Vice President for Activities. They shall convene the meetings, approve agendas, and preside at all meetings. The Vice-Chairperson shall be selected at the discretion of the committee and acts in the absence of the Chairperson.
- IV. MEETINGS** Meetings shall be called by the Chair. The committee shall meet bi-weekly with a minimum of twenty-four (24) hours notice. Meetings may also be called by any member with support of at least twenty-five percent (25%) of the seated, voting membership.
- V. VOTING** Decisions shall be made by consensus. If a consensus cannot be made, any voting member can make a motion. In order for a motion to pass, it must obtain a majority of the legal votes cast. An abstention shall not count as a legal vote cast.
- VI. QUORUM** A majority of the voting membership shall constitute a quorum. If a quorum is not present, the Chair will adjourn the meeting and reschedule to a new day and hour.
- VII. RULES OF OPERATION** The committee may adopt and amend rules of operation governing its operation by a majority vote of the committee, subject to review or approval by the Board of Directors.
- VIII. AMENDMENTS** This Charter may be amended by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.
- IX. REPORTAGE** This committee shall report to the AS Board of Directors through the AS Vice President for Activities.
