**STF PROPOSAL #1, Loan Pool Projection Upgrade**  
(ATUS priority 1)

***Comments***

- Are eight projectors really necessary?
- Maybe replace some projectors now, and the rest over time... rather than eight in one year. They could reapply next year.
- The utilization description (part III) doesn't make total sense.

***Initial Vote: 9 points***

**STF PROPOSAL #2, Concert Hall Live Streaming**  
(CFPA priority 1)

***Comments***

- \$7,499 total, less \$2,000 contribution
- Users do pay rent/fees for use of the PAC.
- Proposal doesn't address the students who would actually access and use the equipment. Assume it would be about four student employees.

***Initial Vote: 5 points***

**STF PROPOSAL #3, Enhance Student Experience and Understanding of Neurophysiology and Behavior**

(CHSS priority 2)

***Comments***

- Only a small group of students would actually use the microscope accessories.

***Initial Vote: 0 points***

**STF PROPOSAL #4, Strength Measurement in the Health Sciences**  
(CHSS priority 1)

***Comments***

- Current equipment is old.
- PEHR is the fastest-growing major, and a bottleneck major.

- The new equipment would last a long time.

**Initial Vote: 12 points,**

***provided that temporary quarters (due to Carver renovation) are adequate. Or, should we defer purchase until Carver is done?***

**STF PROPOSAL #5, Training Students in the Use of Mobile Technology for Communication Enhancement in Communication Disorders**

(CHSS priority 3)

**Comments**

- There are some questions about utilization with unique students, but this is probably OK.
- What would the usage be if we were to have iPads for checkout in this area?
- Has CSD had STF funding in the past? (Diane will find out and report back.)

**Initial Vote: 6 points**

**STF PROPOSAL #6. Humanities Majors - Seminar Room Workstation**

(CHSS priority 4)

**Comments**

- Software "specific to Humanities research" is vague. What specific software do they want? (Josie will find out and report back.)
- Chairs are furniture, which STF doesn't fund.

**Initial Vote: 6 points**

**STF PROPOSAL #7, Enabling Investigative Labs on Gene Function using Tetrahymena and C. elagens**

(CSE priority 1)

**Comments**

- This is fairly sophisticated equipment. Not all students will get to use it; most students will be using the *results* of student manipulation in the other 205 lab.
- [Student member] is fond of equipment that helps the GUR courses.
