### Brief overview of what you would like to accomplish with a proposal?

### Request: Change seating & table arrangement in Rm. VU 567

- 1) The AS BOD is hoping to foster more effective communication during meetings. With the current set up, board members sit side by side in a straight-line. This makes visibility & communication less clear because members often cannot see beyond adjacent individuals.
- 2) The AS BOD hopes to better visually present themselves. Currently, there is only enough seating in the front for 5 of the 7 members. The remaining two sit to the side facing each other. The Board wishes to have a seating arrangement that accommodates the entire group. Closing the gap by adding table creates a presenter/presentee relationship. This would more visually distinguish the Voting Membership & the guests/other attendees.
- 3) As a general use of the room, this would increase the utility of the room. More seats would be available for other meetings.

# What do you anticipate as the impact this project would have on your department?

- 1) I believe that communication during Board meetings would be improved. Many times communication is limited due to visual & auditory impairment. This will allow the chair to more easily identifier speakers. This would allow each board member to see each other & visual gage nonverbal cues.
- 2) The impact would be an increase to the professionalism of the meeting. It is currently unclear who sitting upfront is a guest, nonvoting member or Board member.
- 3) In General, the meeting space would benefit from having more seats available. Many groups (not just the AS) utilize the space. This would a benefit to all those parties.

### What are other alternatives if your proposal is not accepted?


1) Currently, before each BOD meeting, we angle the tables similar to a trapezoid. We would continue to adjust the table set up before meetings.
