Background & Context:

Portland State University will be putting on the 6th year Queer Students of Color Conference from April 16th to the 17th. The two-day conference provides QSOC with different workshops around identity and community building and the chance to meet prominent speakers in the Queer community who are of color. The opportunity is unlike one that is currently available in Washington state. The conference is held by their Queer Student Resource center. The theme and workshops are still being finalized.

Summary of Proposal
