II. INFORMATION ITEMS

a. MEChA - Trip to Arizona

Patricia Pacheco said MEChA is asking for \$350 to pay for air fare to Phoenix, Arizona in order to plan the National MEChA Conference for November 21-23. This conference's theme is "Education," because this year the conference will be held in Chicago, whose educational systems are suffering.

Draw asked if this event has been done before. Pacheco said Rodriguez went last year, but this is her second time, and the first time she had to pay out of pocket to attend.

b. KSA - Jangmadang Tour

Tina Cha said that Liberty In North Korea (LINK) will be coming to Western for their Jangmadang Tour on November 6th. The event is a free event at 6:30 in AW 204, and will include a 30 minute presentation and video about the illegal trade marketing system currently operating in Korea. KSA is requesting \$180 in order to feed the speakers. Rodriguez asked if Cha would like this item be moved to Action Items during this meeting, if time is of the essence. Cha said there's plenty of time.

c. VP for Diversity - Oregon Students of Color Conference

Cristina Rodriguez said that she and seven other students will be going to Eugene, Oregon, from November 13th- 16th. The conference itself would begin on the 14th. Rodriguez said the theme of this year's conference is "Reclaiming our Humanity and Redefining our Narratives: Telling Our Own Stories." This speaks about how communities of color are portrayed in a false or negative light, and how to deal with this social and political inequality, and how to empower oneself to push back against this dichotomy. Rodriguez is requesting \$919.11 for the cost of transportation, hotel fees, food, and conference registration. Anyone on the Committee who is interested in going can sign up. There are currently spots available for three ESC students, two AS employees, and two Students at Large. The application can be found online on the ESC Facebook page, and the deadline is November 4th. Rodriguez said she would like to institutionalize this event so future ESC members will easily be able to attend this conference.
