III. FINANCIAL REPORT - NATE PANELO

Nate said that the only funding requests approved yet have been from MISO and FASA, and he will be making the edits to the Steering Committee budget soon.

IV. ACTION ITEMS

a. MEChA - Trip to Arizona

Patricia Pacheco said that MEChA is requesting \$350 to fund her trip to Arizona to represent Washington and Idaho at the planning of the April MEChA Conference. Panelo asked if MEChA is planning on requesting more funding from Steering. Pacheco said they will likely request money for the actual conference being held in April, because tickets to Chicago are very expensive, but this will be the last occasion they will ask to fund only one person. Fundraising for the club will begin as soon as possible.
