B. Black Student Union - \$1,300-\$ 1,935

Andrea Thompkins said that the BSU is asking for money to fund a number of their members to attend the Women of Color Conference in Chicago on March 26-29th. This conference is dedicated to engaging in grassroots organizing projects, critical conversations, national actions, transnational campaigns, and community building strategies to end colonial, racial, and gender-based violence against women of color, trans and queer people of color, and our communities. Thompkins said the range was given because they do not yet know how many representatives will be attending the event. They will have an exact number of representatives at the next meeting.

C. African Caribbean Club - \$500
