Introduction

The Underground Coffeehouse presented to the AS Structure and Program Advisory Committee on January 6th, 2016. The currently approved statement of purpose for Office is:

"The Underground Coffeehouse programs weekly events in VU 350, including trivia night, open mie night, live music showcasing local and regional talent, and AS club night in order to entertain students and strengthen their connection to the Western community. The Coffeehouse also serves as a venue for creative expression and appreciation as well as social engagement."

This office provides programming on a weekly basis and aspires to be a safe and accepting environment for all people. Programming evolves year to year to reflect changes in music tastes, relevant cultural changes and student preferences. The UGCH is an office under AS Productions and we promote inclusivity on all levels while providing entertainment for students on campus.

Program/Services Provided-

The UGCH provides a community and safe space for students to share their passions and interests with each other without judgement or scrutiny. Consistently putting on events nearly every day of the week, the UGCH has been providing the student body with weekly events such as the Wednesday Night Concert Series, Open Mie Night, Trivia nights, Jazz Jams and so on. Areas for Improvements/Recommendations-

The following are the Structure and Program Advisory committee's recommendations for strategic goals over the next four years:

1. To improve assessment for future years and gather a consistent ûow of data we propose to introduce a surveying podium equipped with a tablet

Assessment in the past has been hmited to the tablets available at the VU front desk, the amount of volunteers at hand and the availability of employees to do surveys. In order to save time and money while consistently gathering assessment data, we propose a podium with a tablet locked inside where attendees of the UGCH can take surveys about their experience in the UGCH. The surveys would be managed by the Assistant Director of Marketing & Assessment and collected on a regular basis.

2. Brins a keyboard to the UGCH to diversify open mics and variety of musical acts*

A high volume of acts during UGCH open mie nights have been limited to guitars and mobile instruments. There is a lack of diversity in music that the UGCH wants to provide. Through a keyboard, the UGCH will provide greater opportunities for musicians to express themselves.

3. Add signase to the UGCH entrances/exits to promote awareness of sensitive programing

In order to respectfully inform people of events and programming that may be sensitive to the theme and/or subject matter, we recommend to place signage along the entrances/exits stating the purpose and theme so that people come to the UGCH with full knowledge of what the programming is for the day. For example, "Erotic Poetry Night may contain sexually exphcit material".

4. Undate mission statement to reûect current programming

The currently approved mission statement reflects a limited view of the current programming and in order to express the evolving atmosphere and environment of the UGCH, we propose a new mission statement.

Below is the proposed new mission statement.

"The Underground Coffeehouse programs free weekly events in VU 350, including hve music showcasing local/regional talent and a variety of special events in order to entertain students and strengthen their connection to the Western community. The Underground Coffeehouse coordinates programming for creative expression and appreciation, as well as social engagement."
