III. ESC Night Market

A. Hugo Sanchez

The members of the committee passed around the sheets that they had been given last week, to provide feedback and ideas about the Night Market. Sanchez said that there were sheets from a few groups that he was still missing. He wanted to start a Facebook group for planning Night Market. Musa said that there was going to be a representative just for Night Market from ACC. Sanchez said that he would like to get their information. Martinez said that she was stepping down, and there would be new representatives for Steering from LSU.

B. ESC Lobby Day

Cervantes said that all applications were ready on OrgSync. Two people from each club were required to go. The dates are February 19th and 20th (President's Day Weekend). Cervantes said that there would be workshops prior to Lobby Days to train people. Guan asked if it was two people maximum, or if more people could go. Cervantes said that she thought it was only two, because there was only one bus. Musa asked what exactly they would be doing at Lobby Days. Cervantes said that she had been to Western Lobby Days, and so had Rutledge. Rutledge explained what the experience would be like based on going to Lobby Days. Cervantes said that the people going would be trained on the issues, such as the ESC Multicultural Center and Tribal Liaison. Cervantes said

that people would be able to give their testimonials, since they already knew about the items on the agenda and were affected by them.
