#### III. Info Items

#### **A.** LSU - La Mezclada (\$2170)

Argueta explained that La Mezclada is happening instead of the Heritage Dinner, to focus on cultures across Latin America rather than just Mexican. An Afro-Cuban singer/songwriter is coming to perform. The event is happening on May 6<sup>th</sup>, from 11 am to 5 pm. The money will go towards food and travel expenses.

#### **B.** MEChA - Low Rider Show (\$2,000)

This year is the 17<sup>th</sup> annual Low Rider Show. Low Riders from all over the area come to Red Square. At least 80 cars come to the event. The cars are on display and can be judged. Several activities happen throughout the day, including contests and performances. The funds will help sustain the show. MEChA raises funds for the show through selling t-shirts, application fees for the low riders, and asking the Diversity Fund for money. Matey asked if there was a way for MEChA to reduce their request, because they'd already asked for around \$4000

from Steering this year. Mejia said that the Low Rider show and MEChA's accounts were separate, and the funds didn't mix. Matey asked what the profit from last year's event was. Mejia said it was around \$2,000. Cervantes put in that MEChA's last request from steering was a loan. Mejia said that they were asking for money from the Diversity Fund and food from Leonard Jones. Mejia said that in the past, one thing they hadn't done was ask for money from the community. This year, they were asking the community for raffle prizes for the baskets. Rutledge suggested using Viking Funder to raise money. Khansila asked about the loan that Cervantes mentioned. Cervantes said that she didn't know; the budget was Bahta's area. Mejia said she could go over the budget again, after looking at what was in their account from last year.
