Elections Appeals Panel Charge & Charter November October 20176

I. CHARGE

Hear appeals made by AS election candidates regarding disqualification in the AS Elections by the AS Election Board. The AS Elections Appeals Panel's decisions are final and may not be overruled by the AS Board of Directors.

II. MEMBERSHIP

No Election Appeals Panel member shall be a candidate, or involved in any candidates campaign.

- 2 Students-at-large

- All members of the AS Board of Directors whom are not seeking election for the following year.

- Dean of Students, Advisor (non-voting)

- Associate Dean of Student Engagement and Director of the Viking Union, Executive Secretary (non-voting)

III. EXECUTIVE

The Executive Secretary shall be the Assistant Dean of Student

Engagement and Director of the Viking Union.

SECRETARY

The Executive Secretary schedules meetings, provides information regarding grievances to the panel and other duties as assigned by the panel.

IV. MEETINGS

Meetings shall be called as necessary by the Executive Secretary, or 2 voting members, with a minimum of twenty-four (24) hours notice.

V. VOTING

In order for a motion to pass, it must obtain a majority of the legal votes cast. An abstention shall not count as a legal vote cast.

VI. QUORUM

A majority of the voting membership shall constitute a quorum. If a quorum is not present, the Executive Secretary will adjourn the meeting and reschedule to a new day and hour.

VII. RULES
OF OPERATION

The Panel may adopt and amend rules governing its operation by a unanimous vote of the legal voting members.

VIII. AMENDMENTS

This Charge & Charter may be amended by a majority vote of the AS Board of Directors This charter may not be amended between the date in which the AS Board of Directors approves the AS Election Code each year and the close of elections, including any grievance process that same year.

IX. REPORTAGE

This council shall report their decisions to the AS Board of Directors.
