Background & Context

From Casey Hayden on 9 January 2019 –

“After further review and assessment of the classification of your Senator positions, it has been determined that your roles most closely align with the student employment designation of “Peer Advisor 3” which places you at \$14.50/hour.”

The new AAG determined this position to be an hourly, not salaried, position. Therefore their pay will need to reflect this.

Summary of Proposal

This is a legal requirement per the State of Washington that we should follow in order to maintain a legitimate organization.
