Reason for Funding: Request for full-funding for advertising materials relating to Local Lobby Day 2019. The costs will cover posters, banners, social media design and trifold agendas for about 50-60 students for Local Lobby Day. These materials will drastically increase our visibility on campus in advertising for Local Lobby Day and thus dramatically increase participation and civic engagement amongst Local Issues, and is therefore of utmost importance in relation to the charge and charter of this council. To clarify, we are requesting 120 total trifold agenda, 60 for City and 60 for County; students will share them and each local official will receive one apiece. An additional 30 posters have been requested, 15 for the Whatcom Community College campus and 15 for the Bellingham Technical College Campus, as both of these institutions lack the concrete funding apparatuses to cover the costs for civic engagement advertising, but have had students in their "AS" express interest. LAC covering their costs will expedite the process of getting these universities on board and further legitimizes ASWWU students by uniting the Lobby efforts of all Bellingham/ Whatcom County colleges/universities.
