Elections Board Charge and Charter

Expires on October 1, 2019

I. CHARGE

The purpose of the Elections Board is to make decisions concerning the fairness of Associated Students Election proceedings by:

- Having hearings regarding candidate grievances
- Making judgments which shall be made according to the Election Board's interpretation of the rules and regulations outlined in the AS Election Code.

II. MEMBERSHIP

Voting:

Chair shall be hired by the AS Personnel Office by the first week of winter quarter and shall not be a candidate, or involved with a candidate's campaign. If the chairperson position is not filled, the AS REP director shall serve as chair (Chair).

Twelve (12) students-at-large, no more than two (2) from any one Western affiliated organization or club, to be appointed by the AS Executive Board.

Non-voting:

Advisor

No Election Board member shall be a candidate, or involved with a candidate's campaign

III. CHAIR

The Chair shall be hired by the AS Personnel Office. They shall convene meetings, approve agendas, preside at all meetings and report all actions taken to the AS Executive Board.

IV. MEETINGS

Meetings shall be called by the Chair as set forth by the Election Code. If more than one grievance is filed, they will be heard in the order in which they were received by the Chair. The proceedings shall follow the rules and regulations as stated in the AS Election Code.

V. APPOINTMENTS

Appointments made by the AS Executive Board cannot be rescinded or changed after the official election process has begun, unless approved by a majority vote of the AS Executive Board.

VI. VOTING

In order for a motion to pass, it must obtain a majority of the legal votes cast. An abstention shall not count as a legal vote cast

VII. QUORUM

Five members, including the chair shall constitute quorum. Each party to a grievance is allowed to disqualify one member from serving on the hearing panel.

The chair cannot be disqualified. Of the twelve (12) students at-large, four (4) will be selected. If committee does not consists of twelve (12) students at large due to lack of interest, quorum shall constitute a majority of confirmed committee members.

VIII. AMENDMENTS

This charter may be amended by a majority vote of the AS Executive Board. This charter may not be amended after the official election process has begun until the official results have been ratified by the AS Executive Board.

IX. REPORTAGE

The Election Board shall report all hearing outcomes to the AS Executive Board.

X. APPEALS

Decisions made by the AS Election Board are considered final with the exception of candidate disqualification. In the event that a candidate is disqualified by the AS Election Board the candidate may appeal this decision to the AS Elections Appeals Panel.
