Background & Context:

The Multicultural Center has been an ongoing project for multiple years, all in which the Vice President for Diversity had a board assistant to organize trips and meetings associated with the MCC renovation. Now that the MCC is built, the VP for Diversity will be a point person in the smooth transition from VU to MCC. The board assistant for this transition will be responsible for organizing meetings, moving dates, stream lining issues, and helping with logistics.

Summary of Proposal

Because this will be the first year the Multicultural Center exists and many things are still unknown the position of ASVP for Diversity will likely be handling many troubleshooting issues in the transition. With this transition there will likely be multiple meetings that need to be had with different offices and help transition clubs into creating a new culture within the MCC.
