I. CHARGE

The purpose of the AS <u>RestructureStructural Review-Committee</u> is to <u>develop and implement structural changes to the ASWWU as to improve efficiency and accessibility of the organization by:continue developing recommendations concerning the Associated Students of Western Washington University's constitution by making recommendations concerning the:</u>

- Evaluating the internal structure of the ASStudent body input into the approval of the new structure
- Working with current professional and student staff to collect input and feedback on proposed AS structural models
- Developing a proposal for a Student Activities Board
- Finalizing Developing an overall proposal for the general AS structure Governance and programming structures within the AS
- Organization of existing AS offices and services in the new structure
- Implementation of the new structure. Implementing changes to the AS, approved by the AS Executive Board and AS Student Senate.

The committee will do this in a manner that increases transparency, accountability, personnel management, and representation within the Association Students

III. CHAIR

The ASVP for Activities Governmental Affairs and AS Business Director shall be cochairs. The co-chairs shall convene meetings, develop agendas, and preside at all meetings. Chairperson shall be the AS Vice President for Governmental Affairs. The Chairperson shall convene the meetings, approve agendas, and preside at all meetings. The Vice Chairperson shall be AS President and acts in the absence of the Chairperson.

IV. MEETINGS

Meetings shall be called by the co-chairs. The committee shall generally meet every other week with a minimum of twenty-four (24) hours' notice. Meetings may also be called by any member with support of at least twenty-five percent (25%) of the seated, voting membership.

V. VOTING

In order for a motion to pass, it must obtain a majority of the legal votes cast. An abstention shall not count as a legal vote cast.

VI. QUORUM

A majority of the voting membership shall constitute a quorum. If a quorum is not present, an informational meeting may be held at which no official actions are taken.

VIII. RULES OF OPERATIONS

The council may adopt and amend rules of operations governing its operation by a majority vote of the council, subject to review and approval by the AS Executive Board.

VIIIIX. AMENDMENTS

This Charter may be amended by a majority vote of the AS Executive Board.

IXX. REPORTAGE

This committee shall report to the AS Executive Board though the AS President.
