Review of Discrimination Complaint Procedure Charter
Expires on June 31, 2020

I. CHARGE

The purpose of the Review of Discrimination Complaint Procedure Charter (RDCP) is to review Western Washington University's existing Discrimination Complaint Procedure (PRO-U1600.02A) to ensure that the procedure adequately protects the students and community of WWU from discrimination/harassment by:

- Reviewing the procedure at WWU and comparing to models at other Universities
- Discussing the procedure with all relevant authorities at WWU
- Drafting proposed changes to the procedure as needed and communicating the need for these changes to all relevant authorities
- Making students aware of the current policy

II. MEMBERSHIP

Voting:

AS Senator for Huxley, Maya Noesen (Chair)
3 AS Student Senators
2 At-Large Students

III. CHAIR

The Chairperson shall be the AS Senator for Huxley, Maya Noesen. They shall convene the meetings, develop agendas, and preside at all meetings. The Vice Chairperson, elected at first meeting, shall act as the Chairperson in their absence.

IV. MEETINGS

Meetings shall be called by the Chair. The committee shall generally meet twice a month with a minimum of twenty-four (24) hours' notice.

V. VOTING

For a motion to pass, it must obtain a majority of the legal votes cast. An abstention shall not count as a legal vote cast.

- a. Quorum: A majority of the voting membership shall constitute a quorum. If a quorum is not present, the Chair will adjourn the meeting and reschedule to a new day and hour.

X. AMENDMENTS

This Charter may be amended by a majority vote of the committee, subject to approval by the AS Student Senate.

XI. REPORTAGE

This committee shall report to the AS Student Senate through the Chair.
