

## **Updated Spring Election Timeline 2**

April 1<sup>st</sup> Monday: Candidate filing begins

May 15<sup>h</sup> Sunday: Candidate filing ends

May 16<sup>th</sup> Monday: Mandatory Candidates meeting

May 17<sup>th</sup> Tuesday: Campaign period opens at 9 am

May 23<sup>th</sup> Monday: Voting Begins

May 27<sup>th</sup> Friday: Voting ends at 4 pm

Under this timeline there is the ability for the Executive Board to advertise their positions at a leadership conference happening on the 13<sup>th</sup> and giving people until the end of the weekend to file. The voting period is shortened but provides the opportunity to be extended. Puts the mandatory candidates meeting from 6-7:30/8:00 pm to accommodate the Senate meeting on the 17<sup>th</sup>

## **Original Timeline Spring Exec & Senate Elections:**

April 1<sup>st</sup>, Monday: Candidate filing begins.

May 5<sup>th</sup>, Thursday: Candidate filing ends and all registration forms must be completed by 12:00 PM.

May 6<sup>th</sup>, Friday: Mandatory candidate meeting

(4:00 PM – 5:00 PM for Senate)

(6:00 PM – 7:00 PM for Executive Board) - probably via Zoom

May 7<sup>th</sup>, Saturday: Campaign period opens at 9 AM. Online campaign materials can now be distributed

May 16<sup>th</sup>, Monday: Beginning of Election

May 20<sup>th</sup> Friday: All voting ends at 4pm
