2005

- Program created
- Named the Green Energy Fee
- Used for purchasing Renewable Energy Credits to offset 100% of campus electricity usage with green energy



2010

- Students voted to renew the fee
- Name changed to Sustainable Action Fund
- Continuation of REC purchasing
- Program begins to offer grants



2018

- Students voted to renew fee
- Name changed to the Sustainability, Equity, & Justice Fund
- Students pay up to \$9 per quarter into the fund
- Support of program such as Green Direct



2022

- Students voted to renew fee
- Students pay up to \$9 per quarter into the fund
- Continued support of program such as Green Direct



Grant Sizes:

- Small (\$500-\$5,000)
- Medium (\$5,000-\$35,000)
- Large (\$35,000+)
