- They are expecting 100 people, but they will not turn people away if they are more
- They are getting Japanese desert that are fish pastries shaped like fish.
- Noah executively approved the request.
- Donna asked if they have the rights to show the film.
- Troy said it's a private event and is a legitimate house bought copy
 - Which makes it ok to play
