THAT, the Student Senate will advocate for diverse and enriching curriculum for all Students; and

THAT, the Members of The Student Senate will maintain active, intentional communication between themselves and those who they represent to the best of their ability; and

THAT, the members of the Student Senate will offer themselves to their peers as advisors and advocates, academic or otherwise; and

THAT, the Student Senate will advocate for and support the further integration of accessibility, diversity, equity, and inclusion into academic affairs; and

THAT, the Student Senate will work alongside the Executive Board and other AS offices and programs to ensure that accessibility, diversity, equity, and inclusion are prioritized within the structures, programming, and policies of the AS; and

THAT, the Student Senate will advocate to the Administration of Western Washington University for continued Diversity in the hiring of faculty and administrators.
