(i) Newly-admitted students who have confirmed their enrollment with the Admission Office prior to the candidate filing deadline but have not yet registered for courses are eligible as candidates as long as they become registered for and maintain the minimum credit load stated above during the quarter coinciding with the start of the term of elected office. Newly admitted students elected to office spring quarter do not need to meet the minimum credit load requirement summer quarter as long as they are registered or plan to register for the minimum credit load before the first day of the subsequent fall quarter.

(i) Newly-admitted students who have confirmed their enrollment with the Admission Office prior to the candidate filing deadline but have not yet registered for courses are eligible as candidates in **special elections** as long as they become registered for and maintain the minimum credit load stated above during the quarter(s) coinciding with the election and the **commencement** of the term of elected office.
