In collaboration with the Outdoor Center and AS Transportation an on-campus event in Red Square to encourage students to register their bikes through a new bike registration program will be held. The funding will go towards purchasing 200 locks from JBI bike, a bike supply wholesaler which the Outdoor Center orders from. These locks will be used as a giveaway to incentivize students to register their bikes through this new system. This will be done by giving the locks away for free to the first 200 registrants to the new registry system. The purchase of these locks will be part of a larger program of overhauling the University's bike security programming through Garage 529. Adopting Garage 529's services will allow WWU to provide to students registration stickers with unique ID codes that will allow anybody (including university departments with access to a staff account) to identify the owner of a bicycle and return it to its rightful owner. This system will reduce thefts both by showing proof of registry on the frame of the bike and by increasing the reporting of theft when it does occur due to increased confidence that the bike will be successfully returned. The registration program will not be funded by this funding request. The only request being made is for funding to acquire the incentive locks which will be given away at the launch of the new registration system.

How will this event benefit the WWU community?

This new program for bike security will help Western students feel confident that their bicycle will not be stolen, and that even if their bike does get stolen they will be able to get it back because there is positive, physical proof of ownership on the bike. According to Katryne Potts, chief of WWU PD, there were 30 (reported) thefts of bikes last year on campus, most around the dorms (The Front). The funds searched for in this grant are for the purchase of a batch of 200 locks to be given away at the launch of the new registration system as an incentive to register one's bike. Providing an option to increase the security of their bicycles will incentivize a larger population of Western Students to ride their bicycle to school every day. This will benefit the health of Western Students through a more active means of transportation. In order to incentivize people to register with the new system, the Outdoor Center is requesting the necessary funds to purchase 200 bike locks to be given away to the first people to register their bike with the new system.
