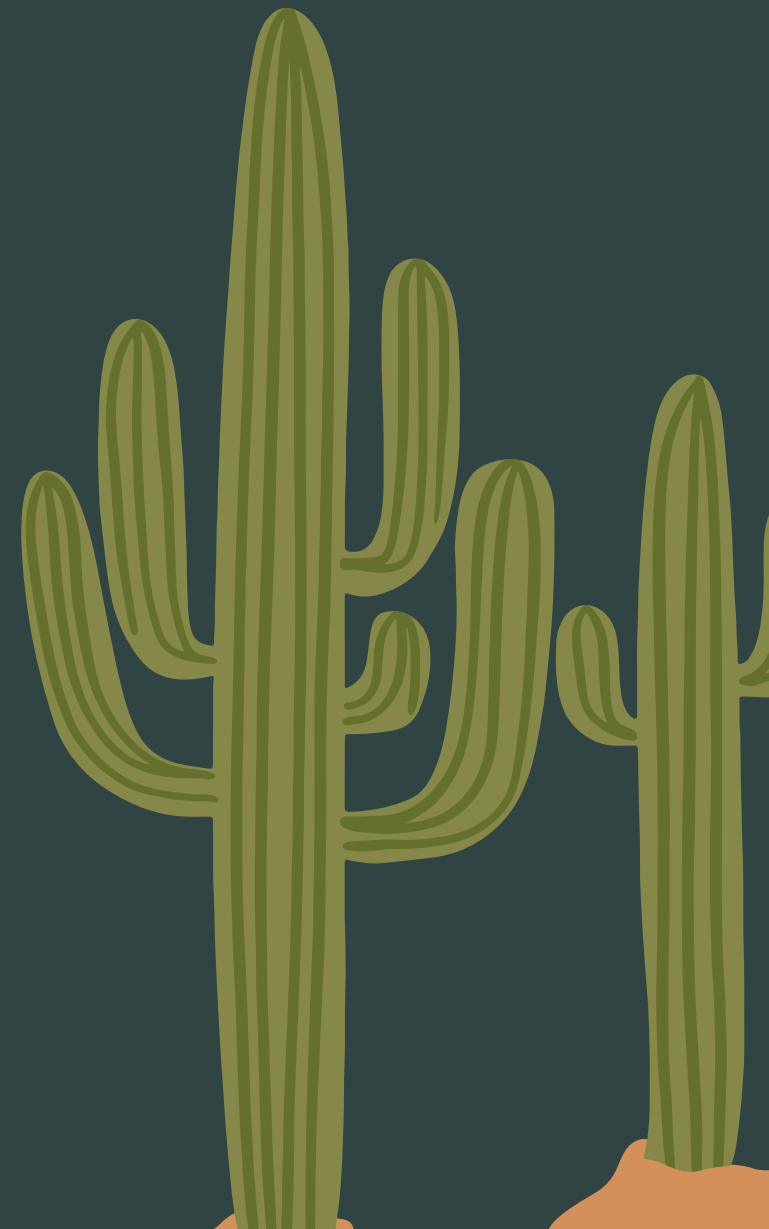
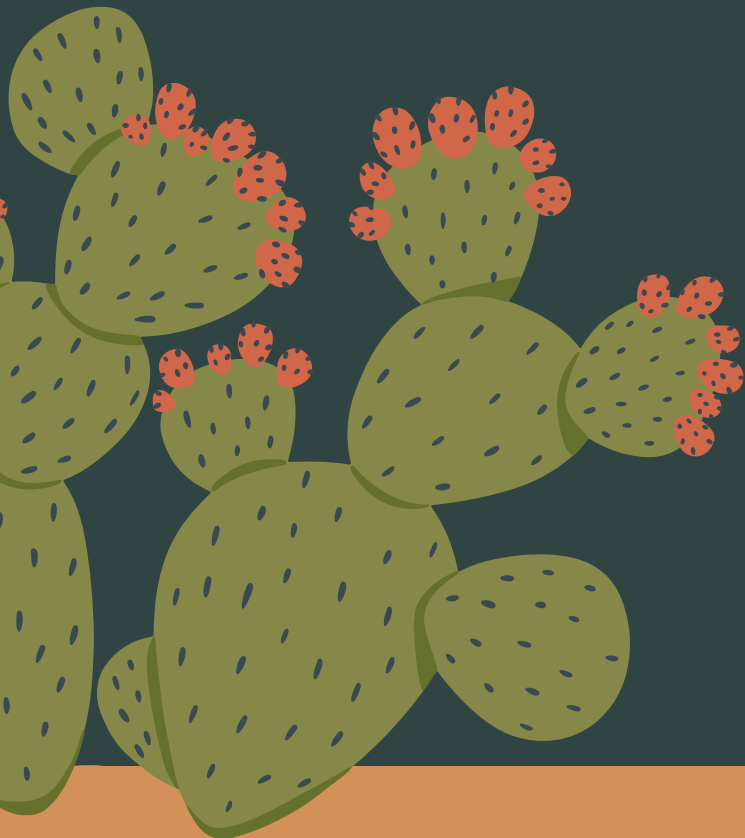

- Parents feel more at ease knowing the resources Western offers





BUDGET

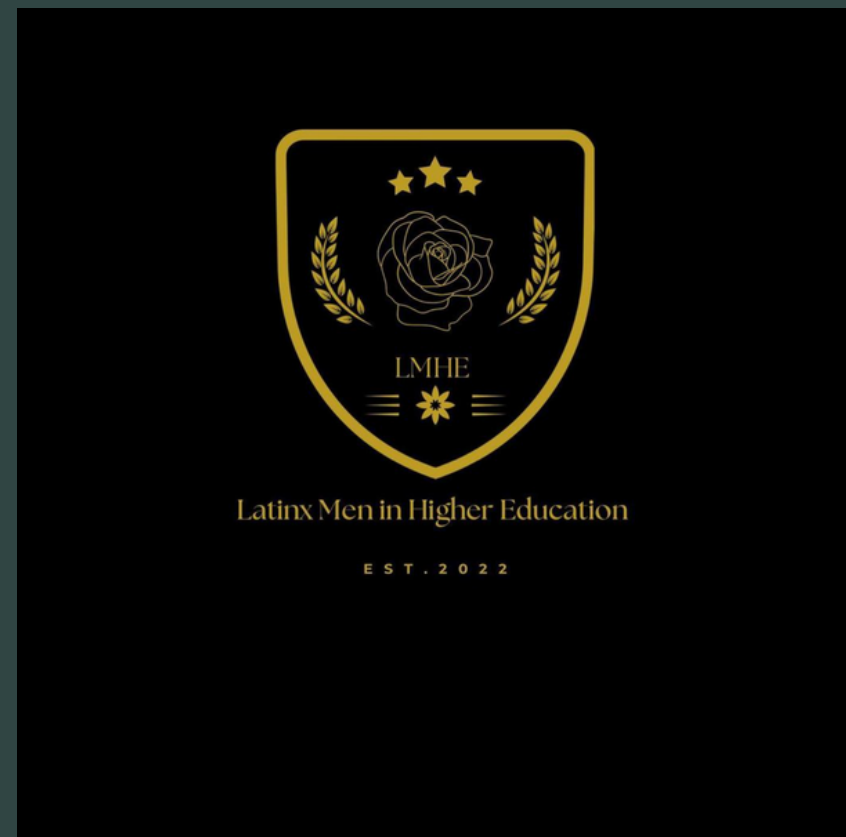


**\$43,880 for 2 years will
