**ASVP for Governmental Affairs:** Resendiz-Eyler reported that he is wrapping up on Local Lobby Day work. He has been in contact with City and County members.

**ASVP for Activities:** Schexnayder reported that it has been hard to get quorum for Activities and the Student Union Advisory Group, and is working on improving that.
