# D. Western Student Chapter of the National Science Teachers Association – \$2,644.45 (Lauren Prescott)

Funds would be for travel to Denver for a National Science Teachers Association convention. Money be used primarily for transportation. They raised 1500 on Give Day. Seven people received scholarships to reduce costs. Council requests that the club comes to a to future meeting with more information because Prescott does not know what they absolutely require.

# E. Financial Management Association - \$3,870 (Yousef Tirhi, Devin Moreno, Rylen Brill)

Financial Management Association requests council to prioritize flights (\$1,531.14) for six people. If approved, funds would only be entered into the FMA account after travel has concluded. They have not filled out the travel form yet. The conference they are traveling to is in New York. Council expresses concerns that if the total (\$1,531.14) is taken from the council's travel budget then the council would have to start using next quarter's budget. FMA has been fundraising. However, they were denied a \$1000 grant from their department. Their Viking Funder is set up but has not been shared and made available for people to donate to. They have contacted Haggen to try to collaborate for funds.
